<p>Link to another page in wikieducator – use double square brackets</p> <p>(This is an internal link)</p> <p>Note: When linking to a page within wikieducator there is no need to type www.wikieducator.org</p> <p>Just type the name of the page.</p>	<p>[[type name of page here]]</p> <p>OR</p> <p>[[type name of page type title you wish public to see]]</p>	
<p>Link to another page outside of wikieducator – use single square brackets</p> <p>(This is an external link)</p>	<p>Type the website without brackets (The raw website address will be displayed)</p> <p>OR</p> <p>[type in website address here]</p>	

	<p>Here, the link will be displayed as a number in brackets like this: [1]. This format is mostly used for citing sources within an article.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>[type in website address here space then Text]. Notice a space is left between the website address and the Text(i.e.description of the website). What appears to the viewer is the Text, not the website address. This is preferred.</p>	
<p>To draw a horizontal line type 4 dashes</p>	<p>----</p>	
<p>To insert your username as a signature after a post type 4 tildes</p>	<p>~~~~</p>

<p>To insert an image with a specified size e.g. 350 pixels</p>	<p>[[Image:type filename 350px]]</p>	
<p>To combine attributes e.g. a framed image with a caption which is left aligned</p>	<p>[[Image:type filename frame left type caption]]</p>	
<p>To insert media files e.g. videos, audio, pdf docs.</p> <p>Note: You add attributes to media in the same manner as for images</p>	<p>[[media:type filename]]</p>	
<p>To insert an iDevice or pedagogical template use double curly brackets</p>	<p>{{type in template name here}}</p>
