Close Reading Exercise for Full Metal Jacket

When we do a close reading of a film scene we look at the following elements:

Camera Work key shots in each segment, noting

- > Framing, camera angle, size of shot, camera movement
- The sequence of the shots

Light, Colour

- > How much, direction it is from, use of shadow or silhouettes etc.
- > Use of warm or cold colours

Editing

> Cuts, dissolves, pace, juxtaposition

Sound

- Dialogue, voice over
- Music, sound effects

Setting

- How is this represented
- ➤ Time/place

Costume

Colour, style, status

Actions

Key actions performed by characters

For each of the elements you identify you need to be able to:

> Explain how the element is used with supporting details.

> Analyse how the element adds to the meaning of the scene.

Meaning refers to character, theme, plot, setting (time or place) and genre.

In total what we are looking at is known as the **Mise en Scene**: Getting a scene together, the choices made about the details of the imaged; what items will be in *it*, and how those items are to be presented.

For this close reading exercise we will be looking at the following key scenes:

- 1. The opening credits/Barber Shop/Barracks (0-7:10)
- 2. DaNang 'Hooch'/DaNang Press Room (46:20-51:00)
