

Maintaining non-engine parts - tutor notes

What students will learn

- About user maintenance of parts of their machines other than the engine
- What parts
- How to look after them

There are a set of worksheets covering different types of equipment – such as:

- outboard motors,
- chainsaws,
- mowers.

Each worksheet covers the *typical* user maintenance needed for that type of equipment. Each make and model will be slightly different in what is needed.

You could create your own worksheet for any other equipment your students need to look after.

Things you need before you start

Tools or equipment

Tools and equipment that students will need.

Maker's information – manuals – on how to do the tasks

You need to work through each sheet with the students, talking about the equipment and how to look after it.
