This is Your Life!

This task will be assessing your ability to:

- Work as a group to produce a dramatic oral presentation.
- Use as many activities as you like to present a "This is Your Life" show to your class.
- Exhibit an understanding of your chosen book in your activities.

Working in small groups, organise, plan and present a **"THIS IS YOUR LIFE"** presentation for your class.

- Brainstorm ideas for at least THREE activities in your groups which will relate to other characters, settings, themes or events in your books. (eg. "Who Am I?" segment where mystery guest gives clues about him or her relating to book).
- Plan and organise HOW your show will be run and presented. Organise parts for your own book segment (each group member will have a segment relating to their own book).
- Practice and present your "show" to your class!

Puppets could be used for extra theatrics!
Role Play works well in this activity!

You will hand in a written copy of your script for assessment once you have completed this task.

- You identify and discuss different language features and their effects in your chosen text, and use these features in speaking, adapting them to your presentation.

Speak confidently and clearly in small and large groups to recount experiences and events, and communicate information, ideas, and opinions, respecting and responding to others.

Key Indicators

- You speak confidently in your group to recount experiences and events, and communicate information, ideas, and opinions from your chosen text, respecting and responding to others.
- Using your chosen text, you present 'This is Your Life', arranging material effectively and using appropriate speech and delivery to clarify and explore meaning.
- You identify language features and their effects in your chosen text, and describe and analyse their relationship to meaning, purpose, and audience, adapting these features for 'This is Your Life'.

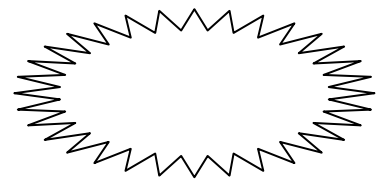
