

Installing Ubuntu "Alternate" CD in NZ

The computer needs to be 500mhz or faster and have 256mb Ram.
The alternate CD is more suitable for **slower/older computers**.

Plug all cables necessary into the computer

Turn on the computer and insert the Ubuntu CD

Turn off the computer and restart with the CD inserted

On the screen choose **English** language and **Install** Ubuntu

Wait patiently

Country **New Zealand** Keyboard Layout **USA** Keyboard Origin **Usa**

Host name: **school** Clock: **Auckland**

Partition: **Use Entire Disk** (this gets rid of nasties on the hard drive)

Write changes to the disk: **Yes** Full name: **school** User name: **school**
(All our school computers are named school)

Password eg j8cu6BT (mix of 8 numbers/letters)
(All school computers have the same password)

Click **Install**

Wait patiently

Encrypt your home directory: **No** Proxy: **Leave blank/continue**

Finish installation: **Yes**

Computer will flick out the CD drawer - take out CD press **enter**

Done

It will restart on its own

Type in user name and password

You are now ready for Ubuntu tweaks
