Weeks	Class sessions	Topics
1. 1 to 7 August <i>Introduction to the subject</i>	Online meeting: 4 August – 16:00–17:00	Orientation to the course and the class participants in an online meeting. Activity one: post your introduction on your blog.
2. 8 to 14 August <i>An overview of evaluation and quality?</i>	Discussion forum	Evaluation in eLearning – the ADDIE model of educational design and using benchmarks to measure quality. Activity two: participate in the discussion about the evaluation of eLearning.
3. 15 to 21 August <i>Methods of evaluation and projects</i>	Online meeting: 16 August - 19:00–20:00	Explore different types of evaluation and the methods to be used in the projects. Activity three: explore literature about evaluation, and post a summary to your blog. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use the discussion forum to organise yourselves into groups for the evaluation projects - negotiate your methods of working collaboratively.
4. 22 to 28 August <i>Planning evaluation – rationale, goals decisions</i>	Online meeting: tba	Explore the reasons for your evaluation project, goals and the decisions to be made - begin the plan. Feedback process is outlined. Activity four: describe the <i>background and rationale, goals, and decisions</i> - on your project wiki.
5. 29 August to 4 September <i>Planning evaluation – purpose, evaluation questions</i>	Group work	Decide on the purpose of the evaluation, and invite feedback from the class on your plan. Activity five: discuss and prepare the <i>aim</i> and the <i>evaluation questions</i> to fit with the <i>decisions</i> - on your project wiki. Use forum to ask for feedback from the class.
6. & 7. (2 wks) 5 to 18 September <i>Planning evaluation – evaluation design</i>	Online meeting: tba	Explore and prepare the evaluation design (methodology) - sampling methods, instruments, triangulation, and analysis of data. Activity six: collaborate in your groups to design the evaluation – add to your project wiki.
8. 19 to 25 September <i>Planning evaluation –draft plan</i>	Group work	Continue developing the plan and request feedback. Activity seven: prepare other sections of the plan to complete a draft plan – limitations, logistics and time line, budget, references and appendices - add to your project wiki.

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9. 26 Sept to 2 October <i>Planning evaluation - finalising plan</i>	Online meeting: tba	Finalise the evaluation plan, and schedule data collection. Activity eight: incorporate feedback into the plan, finalise and submit the final plan. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Organise collection of data – send out invitations to participate.
10. 3 to 9 October <i>Reflection of group evaluation process</i>	Self-directed work	Reflect on the group evaluation processes you have undertaken. Activity nine: report and reflect on the personal contributions you have made to the group process, and what you learned about working in a group – post to blog.

11. & 12. (2 wks) 24 October to 6 November <i>Conducting evaluation</i>	Online meeting: (wk11) tba Group work	Overview of collecting, analysing and interpreting data for evaluation. Activity ten: analyse data and write up the findings – prepare tables, graphs and explanations – add to your project wiki. Submit final results (wk12).
13. 7 to 13 November <i>Evaluation literature</i>	Discussion forum	Discuss examples of evaluation literature that can be used in your report. Activity eleven: search for and select suitable articles or reports to discuss on the forum.
14. & 15. (2 wks) 14 to 27 November <i>Evaluation reporting – Discussion.</i>	Online meeting: (wk14) tba Group work	Prepare a draft discussion about your evaluation results, report this to the class and invite feedback. Activity twelve: collaborate to prepare a draft report with discussion of your findings – add to your project wiki.
16. 28 Nov to 4 December <i>Evaluation reporting – draft report</i>	Group work	Prepare a draft report – add conclusion and recommendations, executive summary and reference list. Activity thirteen: collaborate to prepare a draft of the final sections of the report – add to your project wiki. Invite feedback.
17. 5 to 11 December <i>Finalising the Evaluation process</i>	Group work & self-directed work	Finalise the evaluation report, and your reflections about the evaluation process. Activity fourteen: Submit the final evaluation report. Summarise your reflections about the evaluation process – post to blog.
