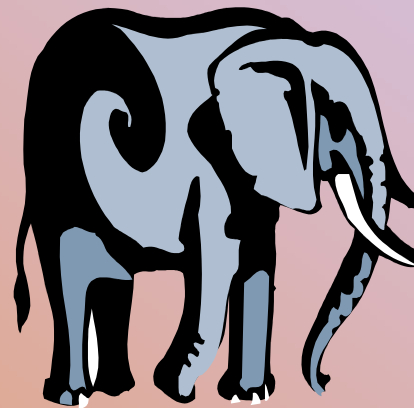
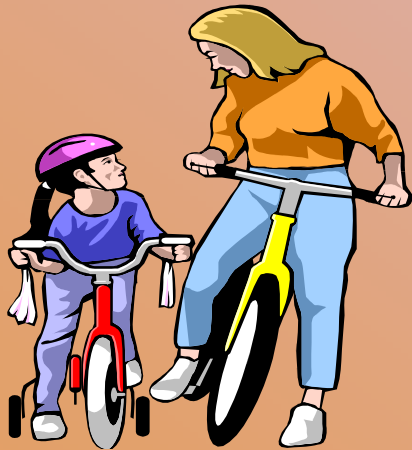
# A NOUN

- Word used as the name of a person, place or thing



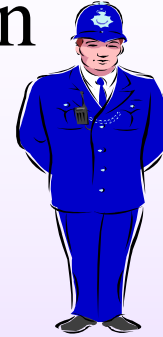
# AN ADJECTIVE

- Short girl                      thin man                      small animal

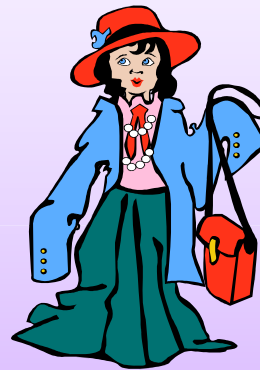


# A PRONOUN

- He, His, Him

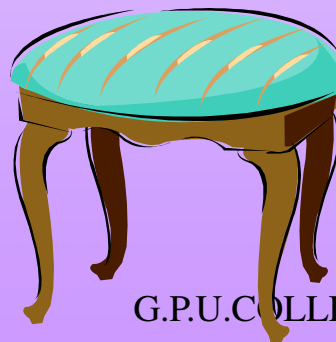


- She, Her, Hers

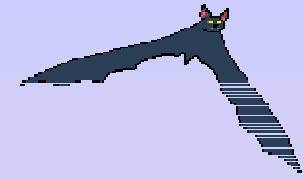


- They, Their, Them, We, Us, Our

Word used to show the relationship between a noun and another word in the sentence.

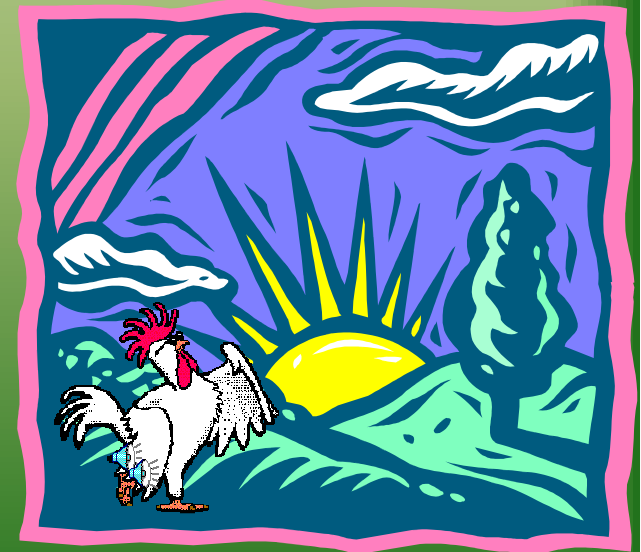
- He arrived by train.

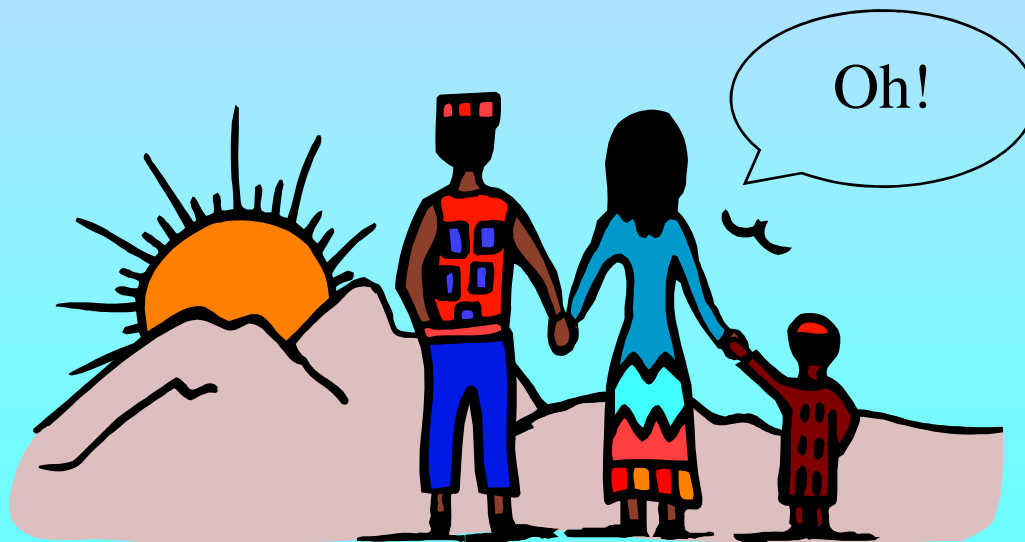


# AN INTERJECTION
